WELCOME TO OUR NEW LOOK NEWSLETTER!

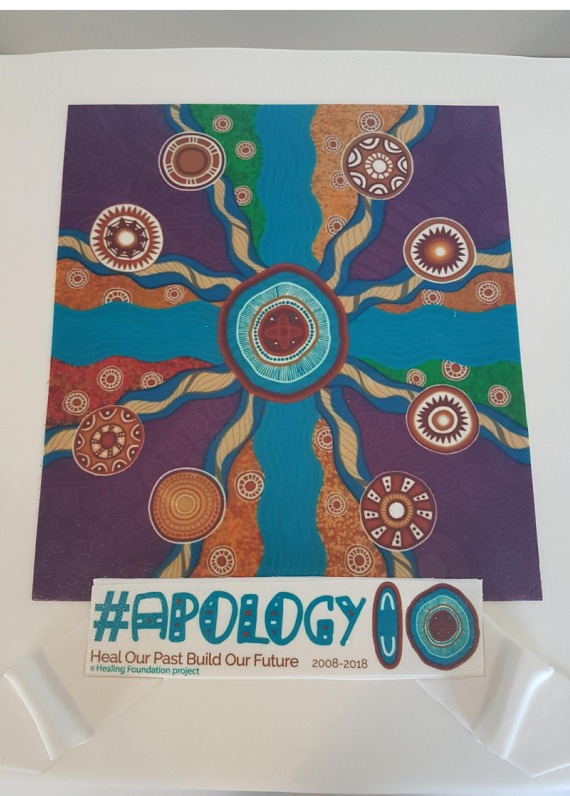
